Dear BPC Owner:

According to the latest news reports, the number of COVID-19 cases, largely driven by the Omicron variant, has exceeded past levels of infection. This particular variant is present in all the states of the country. It actually blanketed the country in just a matter of weeks.

In view of the uncertainties surrounding the Omicron variant we feel it is necessary to restate the COVID-19 protocols we put in place during 2020/2021. As a reminder these rules are as follows:

- You must bring your own masks and sanitizers. Masks must be worn when in the common areas and areas where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Masks are required when entering the office/laundry building.
- People using the washers, dryers and grills must sanitize them before and after each use. Materials and instructions for sanitizing the equipment are available in each area.
- Check in time is on **Saturday at 6:00 p.m.** Earlier access may be possible on an exception basis as determined by the General Manager. Checkout time is **10:00 a.m.** which is required to ensure a timely check in of arriving owners/guests.
- While extra blankets, pillows and bed linens have been removed from the units, the main bed will be made up as usual with the exception of bedspreads. Blankets and bed linens are laundered weekly.
- While we encourage you to bring your own blankets, if you need an extra blanket or bed linens you can obtain them from the resort General Manager. You should advise the General Manager ahead of time of this need by emailing resortmanager@brantpointcourtyard.com.
- The outside shower is operative but is not, and will not, be sanitized after each use.
- Salt, pepper, sugar, sweetener, toilet paper, etc., are still provided. The communal refrigerator has been removed.

We will be monitoring state and local agencies to obtain the latest directives to be followed and will advise you accordingly.

This is not the message I would prefer to be sending but if we all work together and follow the rules we minimize our chances of either being infected or transmitting the virus to others.
